Parent Responsibilities

- 30 hours of volunteer service to benefit the school and help my child and others learn.
- Ensure that my child arrives at school on time ready to learn.
- Ensure that my child arrives at school wearing the appropriate school uniform (navy blue sport shirt, khaki shorts/pants/skirt, tennis shoes and socks).
- Ensure that my child arrives at school everyday with homework assignment completed.
- To attend at least two parent-teacher conference per school year.
- To attend CRMA parent training session at the beginning of the school year.
- To attend at least two open house events a year.
- To attend two Montessori workshops a year.
- To have conflicts over the parent contract be resolved by a committee of the conflict resolution appointee, one board member and one member of the school staff.
- To abide by any other rules and regulations the Committee, with approval of the Governing Board, may establish to operate the school.
- To pick up your children on time. There is a \$25.00 late fee each time you are late.
- To abide by the four anti bullying rules:
 1. We will not bully others.
 2. We will try to help students who are bullied.
 3. We will try to include students who are left out.
 4. If we know that somebody is being bullied, we will tell an adult at school and an adult at home.
